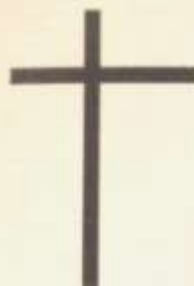
FOREWORD

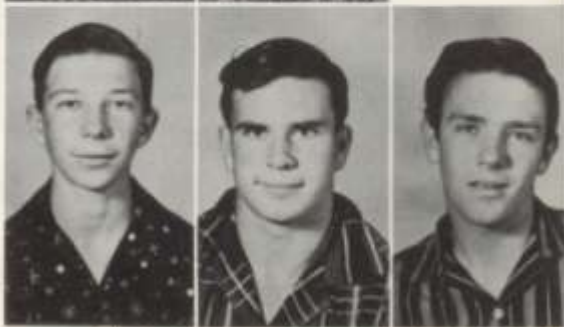

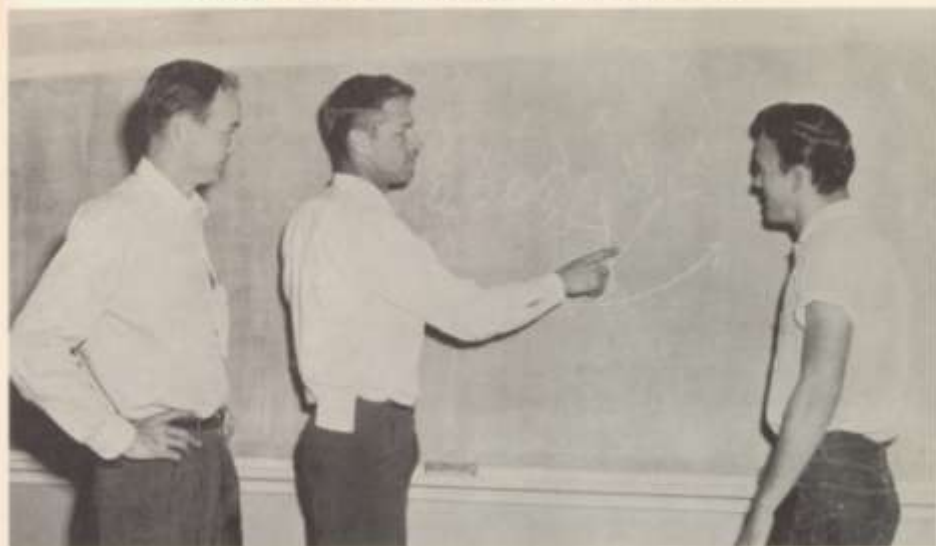
