Candidates from the twelve classes helped make the Festival a gala affair.

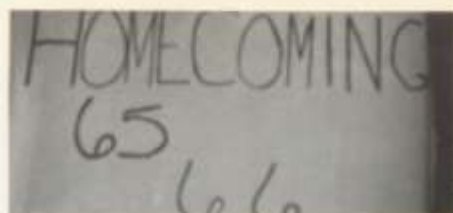

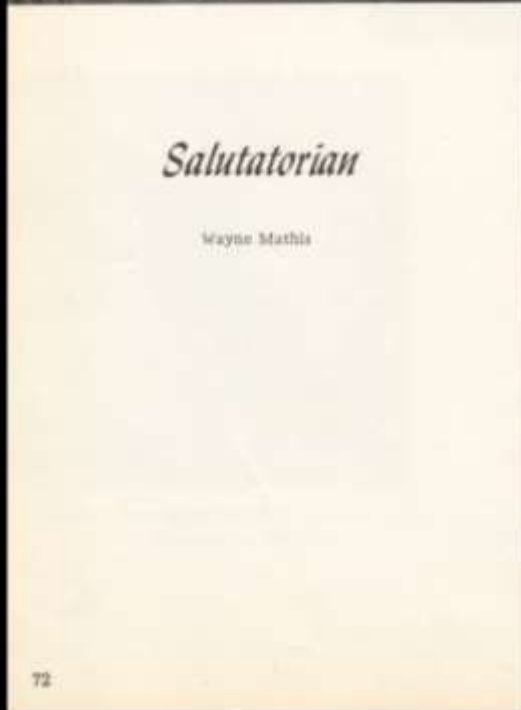

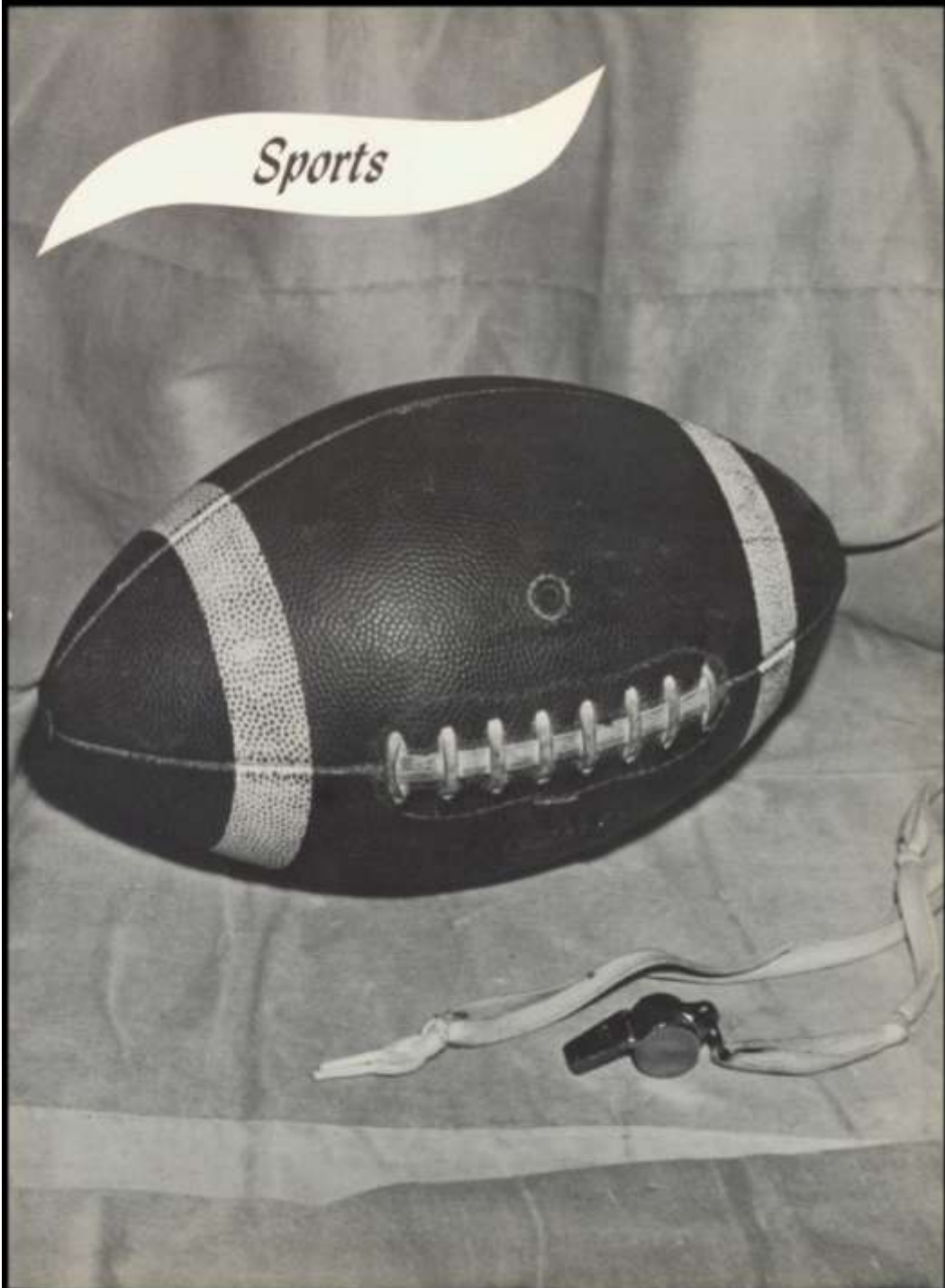
